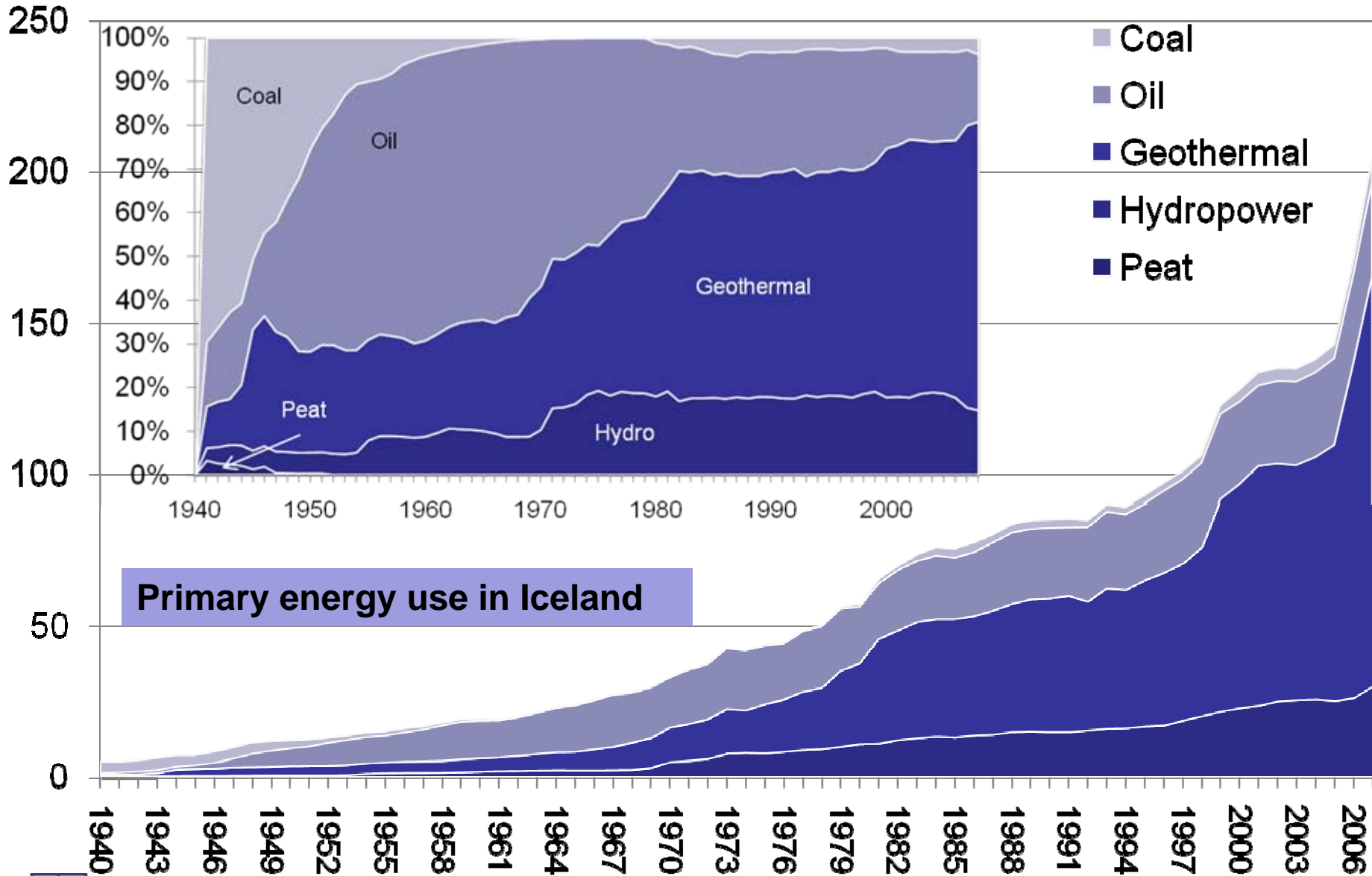

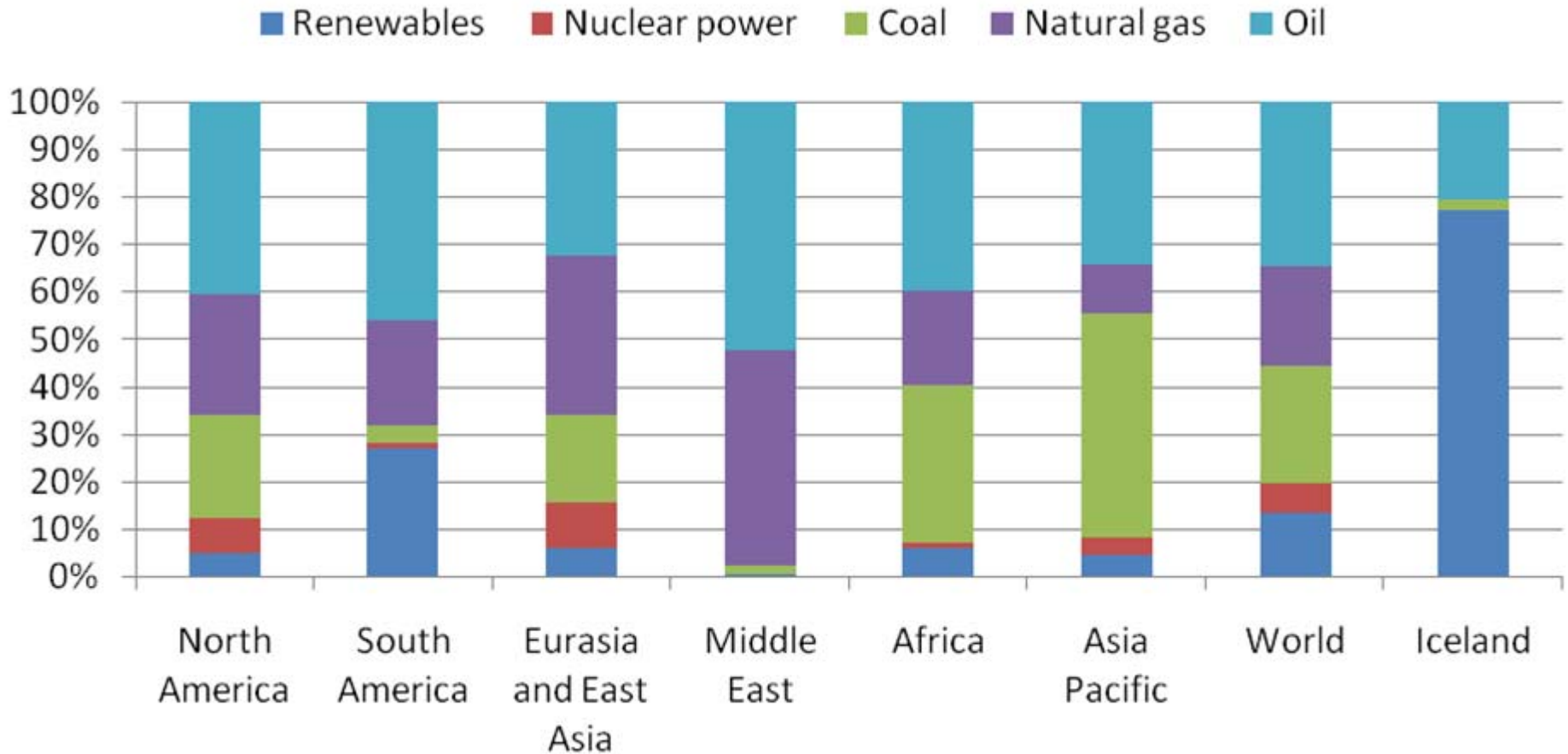

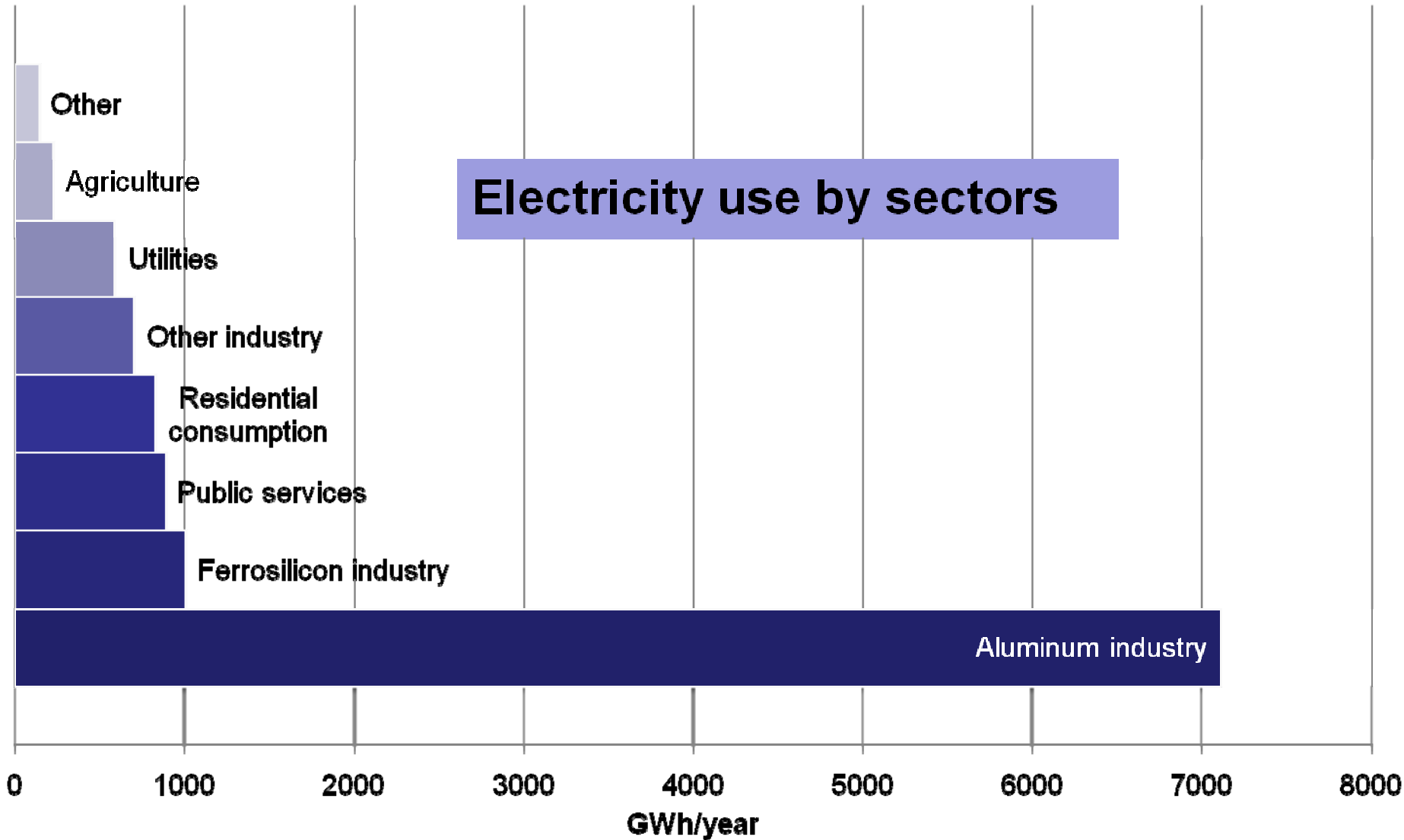
Primary energy use in Iceland

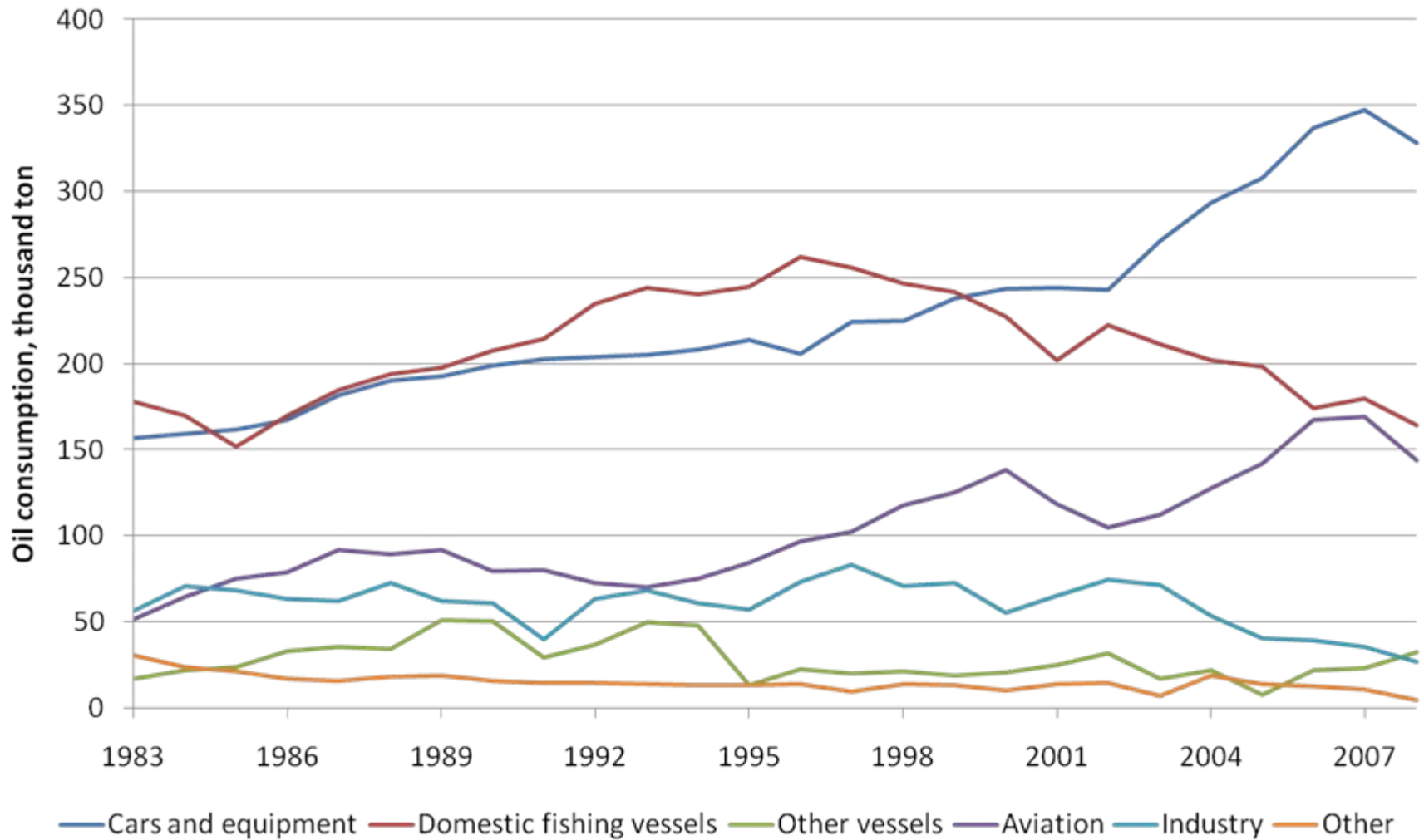

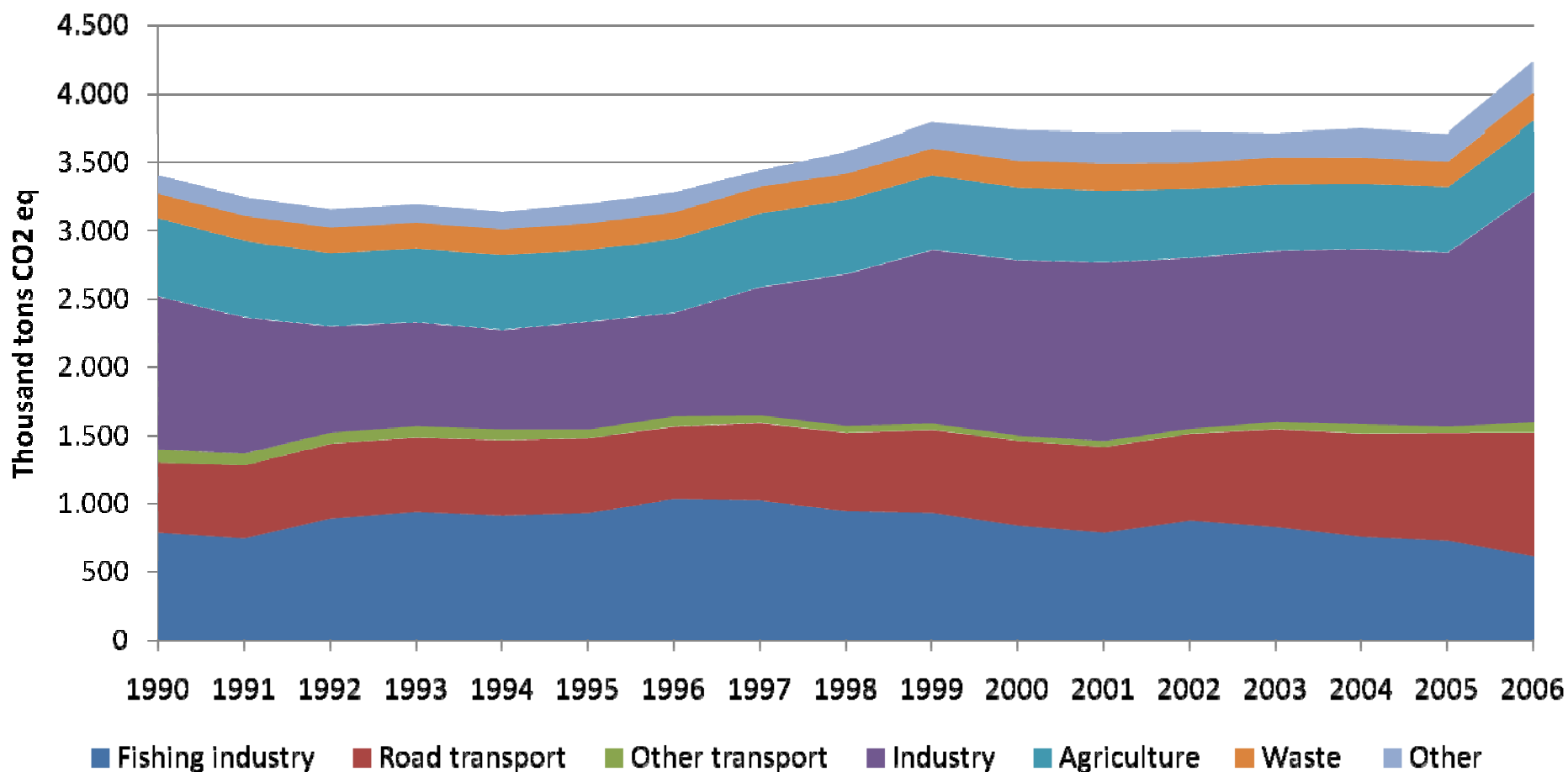
Electricity use by sectors

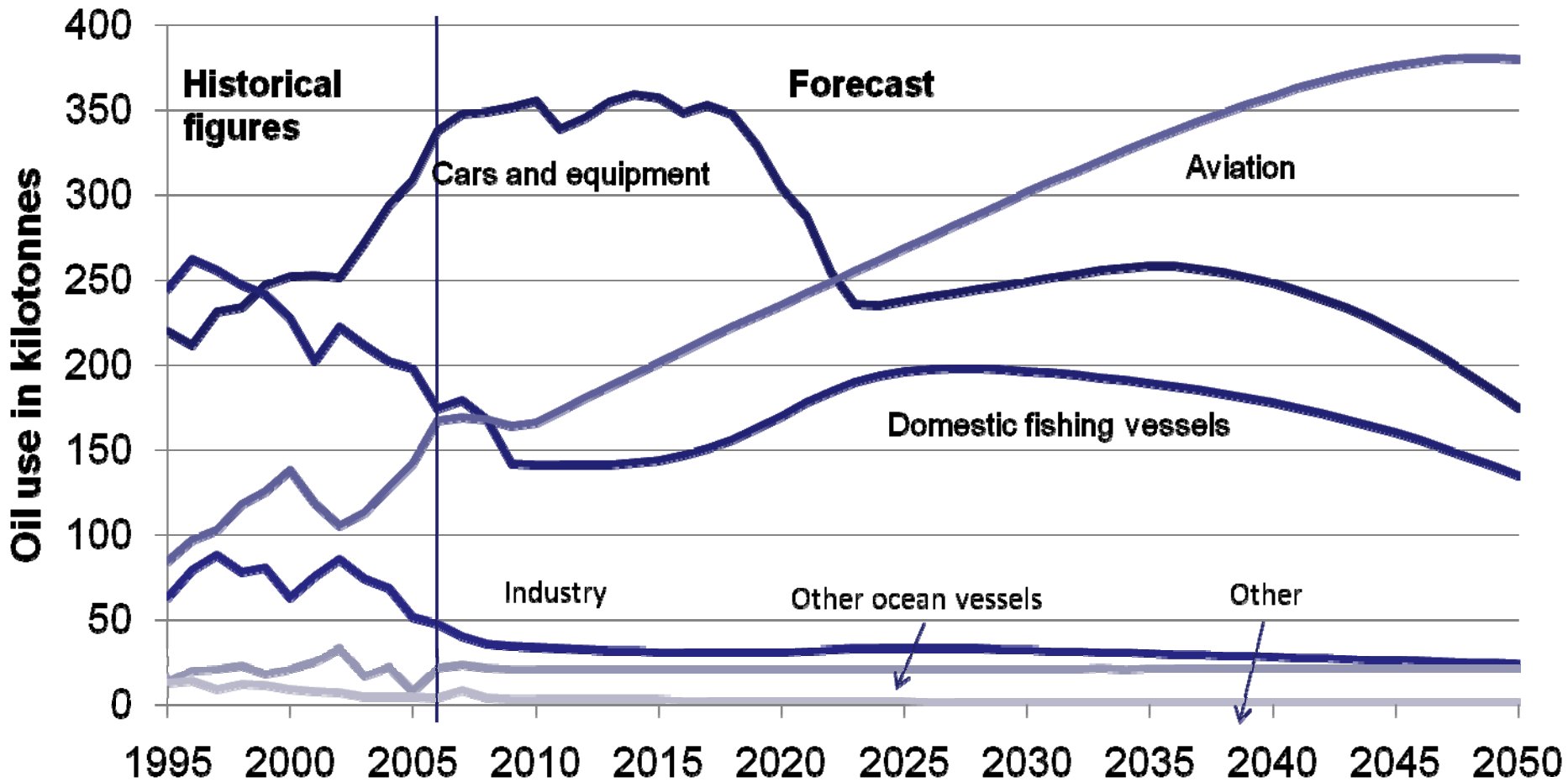
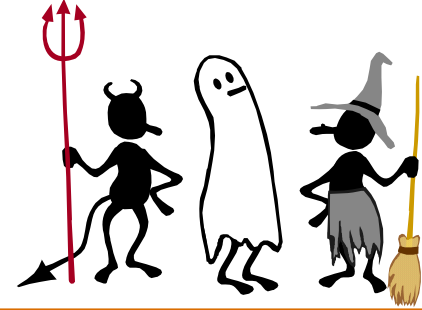


The Good



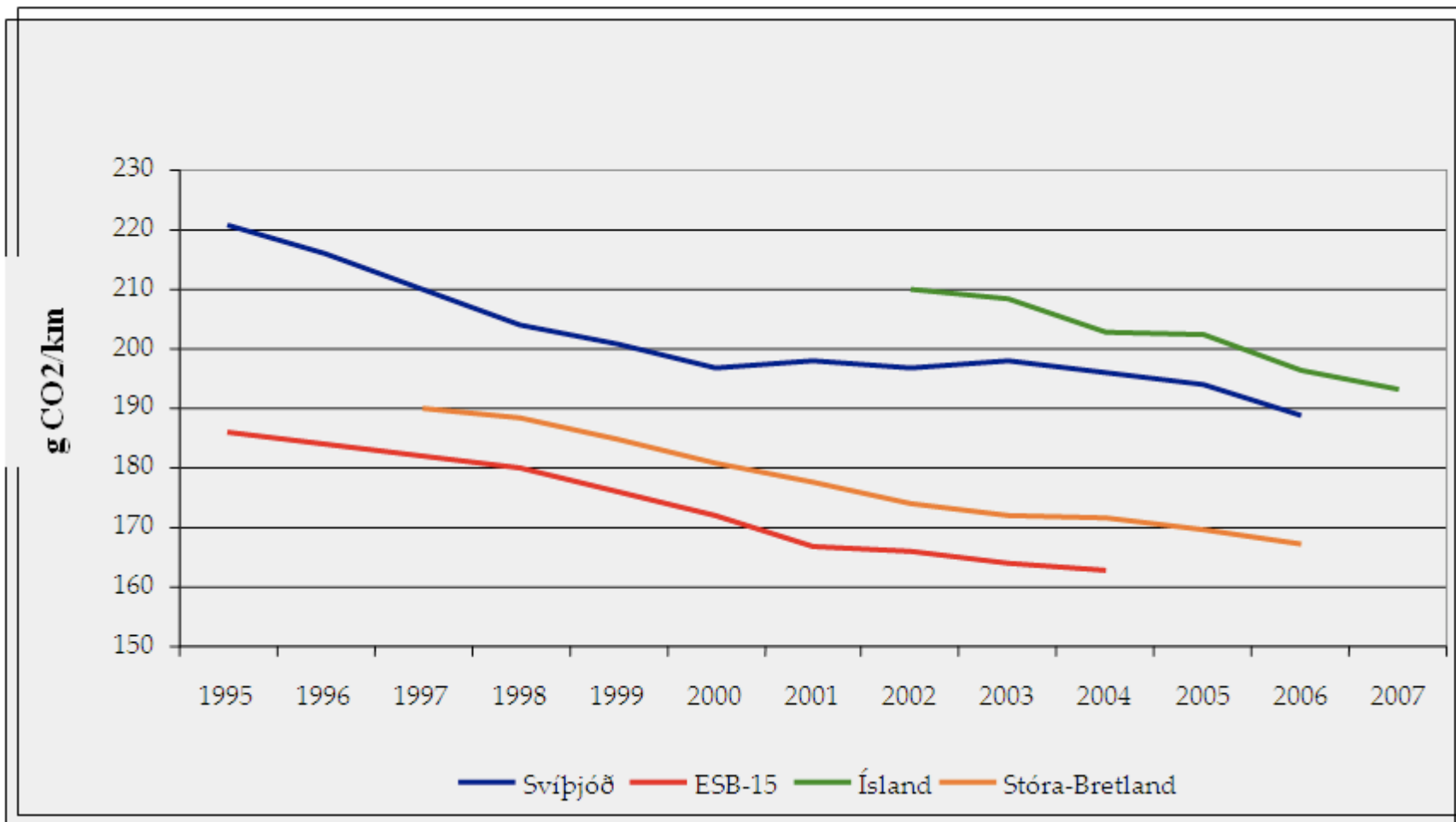
- Transport
