As the world's preeminent energy community member network, the World Energy Council convened, by special invitation, over 250 energy leaders with bright minds, generous hearts and experienced hands from over 60 countries at the **Energy Trilemma Summit.** Co-hosted by the Scottish Government and with the support of Aberdeen City Council and P&J Live, this first in-person convening of the Council's worldwide energy community in three years provided a timely forum to reset the energy conversation.

Under the theme **'Transformational solutions in turbulent times'**, we made sense of the highly uneven impacts of multiple crises and first global demand-driven energy shock. We welcomed positive signals of the new and diverse models for mobilising clean and just energy transitions at pace and scale, which are emerging from different regions and at different levels of society.


