- The past 100 years can be characterised by different eras of energy transition: Energy for Peace, Energy for Growth and Energy for People, Planet and Prosperity.
- Four global drivers of change **the 4Ds** decarbonisation, decentralisation, digitalisation and disruption in demand are shaping the pace and direction of global energy transition.
- There is an emerging ecosystem that could see hydrogen in 10% of energy mix by 2040 with continued government support, suitable regulatory frameworks and interest from society and investors. The colour of clean hydrogen doesn't matter as long as it is carbon free.
- The pandemic has exposed the fragility of established systems with attention refocusing on energy resilience instead of security. Despite the pandemic, climate change remains the biggest threat to humanity.
- There is quiet but confident optimism across all regions about post-pandemic recoveries accelerating transition in diverse but more inclusive ways. Energy is not a single issue or a single sector, it is the ultimate connector.
- Humanising energy reflects a paramount need for demand-driven solutions. It directs leadership attention to the new and shifting energy needs of billions of people and empowers the new consumer voice in energy.
